NEW HOUSING NEEDS LOCAL SERVICES

About 100 houses will soon be built on land between Battlefield Road and the railway line. The access will be from Battlefield Road and this will add more traffic to this already busy stretch of road.




Local people have been told for years that building the North West Relief Road (NWRR) will help with traffic in this area. In fact the NWRR will mean more traffic around the edge of Shrewsbury. Shropshire Council knows that Battlefield Link Road will have more traffic on it (almost 50% more). The council's Highways team are already concerned about the amount of traffic on Battlefield Roundabout, and that's before the impact of the NWRR.

Like thousands of others we are against building the NWRR. Shropshire Council can't afford it. When new housing is built, it should be easy for people to walk, cycle or catch a bus to school, work or the shops. This is the best way to reduce traffic and we will work hard to try and get these put into the development. 26 new houses and flats are also going ahead on Albert Road. Please get in touch if you have any concerns while the building work is being done.

GREEN SPACES

A local resident has suggested that unused areas of land and verges could be planted with wildflowers as has been done in other parts of Shrewsbury. We're following up this idea, let us know if you know a piece of land where you'd like to see it happen.
