Our local GP surgeries have said they **D0 NOT** plan to move. Earlier this year we heard about a proposed new Health and Wellbeing Hub, which some other Shrewsbury GP practices will move to. Details of where this new building might be, and what services it would offer, have not been spelled out and we know that many of you had concerns that it would not be convenient to get to.

There will be another round of **PUBLIC CONSULTATION** in the autumn and we will be watching what happens next, and any possible impact on our local services in this area.



BUSES

Staff and patients at Radbrook Surgery were among very many of you who objected when the bus service 20 was due to be removed in April. Cllr Julia Evans has been working hard with other councillors and staff on ways to save the Radbrook bus service. She is hoping that the current service can be saved until March and then a more permanent solution can be found. Keep an eye on our Facebook page for updates.

BOWBROOK SCHOOLS

THE PLANNING APPLICATION for the new schools will be decided on the 16 August. Your Green Councillors have made comments to Shropshire Council and also met with the developers themselves, to emphasise the concerns that local residents have about the construction phase in particular.

It is a very tight timetable to have both the Primary and the Special Educational Needs schools ready to open in September 2023, but we do expect these much needed schools to be approved. We'll continue to press hard on the traffic issues, both during construction and when the schools open.

Hedges and tree issues are reported to trees@shropshire.gov.uk; and if you want to keep up with all the roadworks in the county, go to https://one. network.

Over the last year Cllr Julia Evans has reported various issues such as noisy drain covers, overhanging trees and fly tipping. Unfortunately, reporting issues does not get the work done any faster!

Please note that **STREETLIGHTS WILL BE REPLACED** with more efficient and energy saving LED lights during the next couple of years, and some of the area's lights are so old, the parts to fix them are unavailable.
