

The next PUBLIC MEETING is on Friday 14th July, 7pm at the Radbrook Community Centre. We're very pleased that Shropshire Council has funds from the Government's Active Travel Fund to work up plans for Longden Road and Bank Farm Road, which are used by so many people walking and cycling. This money is for road safety design work, and once approved the scheme should be ready to be built as soon as there is further funding.

Shropshire Council officers will explain the proposed work and timescales. PLEASE COME ALONG and give your views. While this is good news, we'll be asking the officers how soon the promised Vehicle Activated Signs on Bank Farm Road can be installed.

BUS SERVICE CHANGES FROM SEPTEMBER

Chris and Julia understand the importance of the 20 BUS SERVICE for our area and have been working hard to keep it going since it first came under threat a year ago. You may have seen them travelling on the buses recently and talking to regular passengers about their experiences.

The services are well used, with people standing at peak times, so it's a surprise to see Shropshire Council say that numbers are dropping. The route has been subsidised since April 2022, but now Shropshire Council have announced they intend to replace the 20 (and the 546 to Pulverbathch) with new "Connect On-Demand" buses. Passengers will need to book the service, instead of it running to a regular timetable. It is not clear how this will meet the needs of our busy suburb where people rely on the bus at peak times.


HOME SECURITY

CHANGES TO OUR BOUNDARIES



Boundaries in Shropshire will soon be changing to make the number of voters in each area more equal. Proposed new boundaries have been drawn up by the Local Government Boundary Commission (LGBC). Radbrook has a lot more voters than average, and will continue to grow.

The suggestion is to MOVE PART OF OUR WARD (around Ridgebourne Road) into the Porthill ward, and another part, (Oakfield Estate, Ryelands and Sandiway) into the Copthorne ward.
